## VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Volunteers allow us to allocate more of our financial resources to meeting the needs of our families. We are looking for volunteers who are compassionate, dedicated, and sensitive to the needs of our families. A background check is required and training is provided. ***Always seeking volunteers who love to smile!***

Volunteers support our House in many ways. We are always open to new ideas and are interested in exploring how **your** strengths can be best utilized at RMHCA.

### Welcome Center Shifts Available – 9am-12pm; 1pm-4pm; 5pm-8pm

Welcome Center volunteers play an important role in service to families as well as the organization. These volunteers are the welcoming “face” of RMHCA and to provide administrative support as needed. **General responsibilities include:**

- Greet families and visitors
- Answer telephone
- Assist with administrative tasks as need
- Guide tours as needed
- Discretely handle confidential information
- Be a sympathetic ear or share a laugh

Evening volunteers will also be responsible for assisting in the dining room. **General responsibilities include:**

- Reminding families to wash their hands
- Monitor small children
- Clean up spills (on counter or floors)
- Packs away leftovers and store properly in the Community Fridge
- Clean up dining room and pantry by placing dishes in the dishwasher, wiping down counters, cabinets, and floors

### Supper Club (Breakfast, Lunch or Dinner) Seven Days a Week

Get your favorite recipes together to provide families at the Ronald McDonald House with a warm meal after a long day at the hospital. Breakfast and Lunch (40 people) - Dinner (60-70 people).
